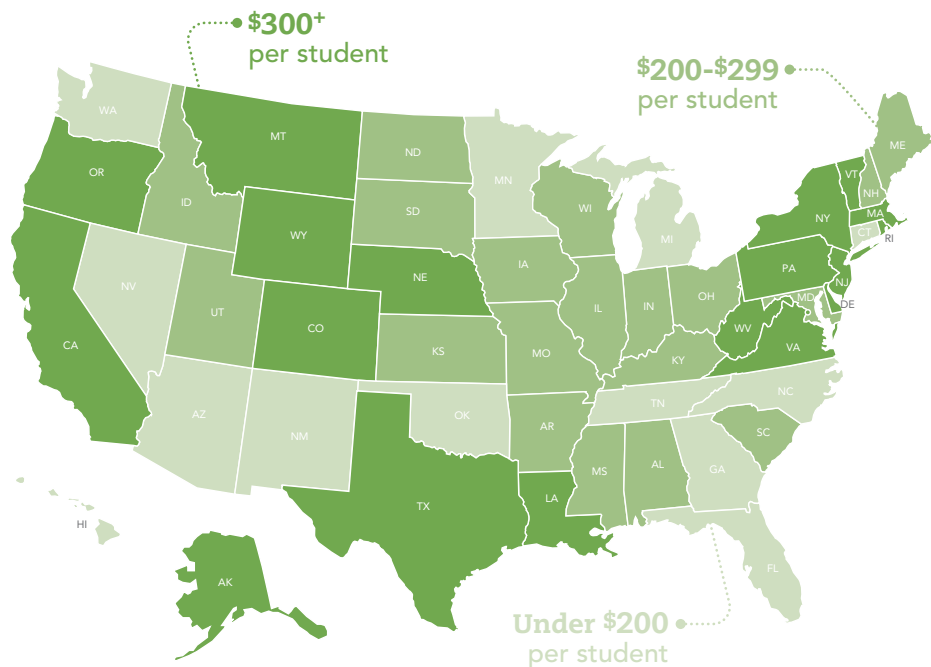
2016-2017 school year

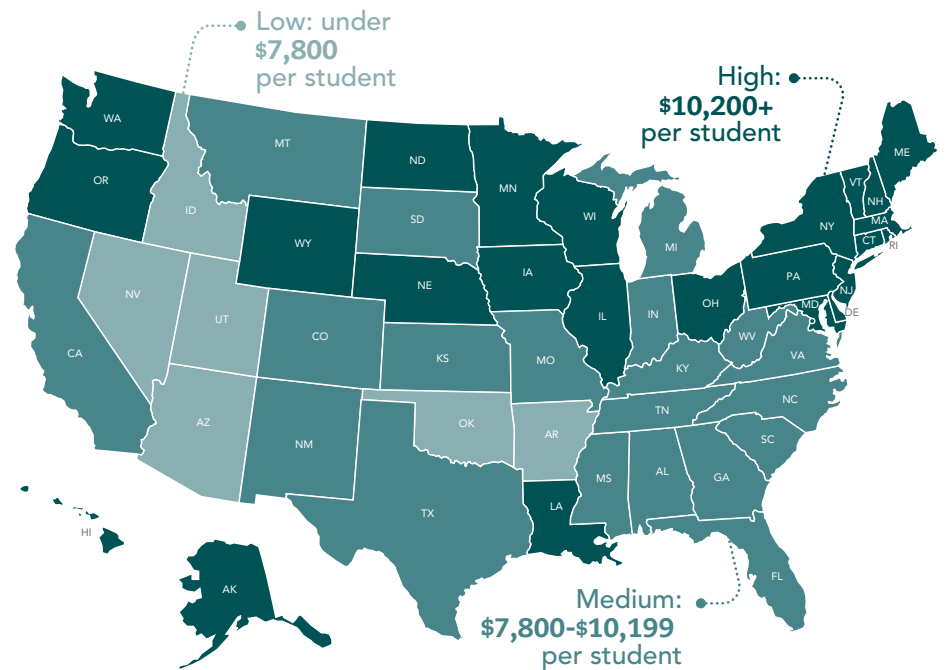
AIM details how much schools spend on all supplies and materials used for instructional purposes. Educational media supplies and software are included. Hardware technology is not included.

Current Expenditures reflect the total operating cost for the district and include the functions of instruction, support services, and food service. Capital outlay, pupil transportation, and debt services are not included.



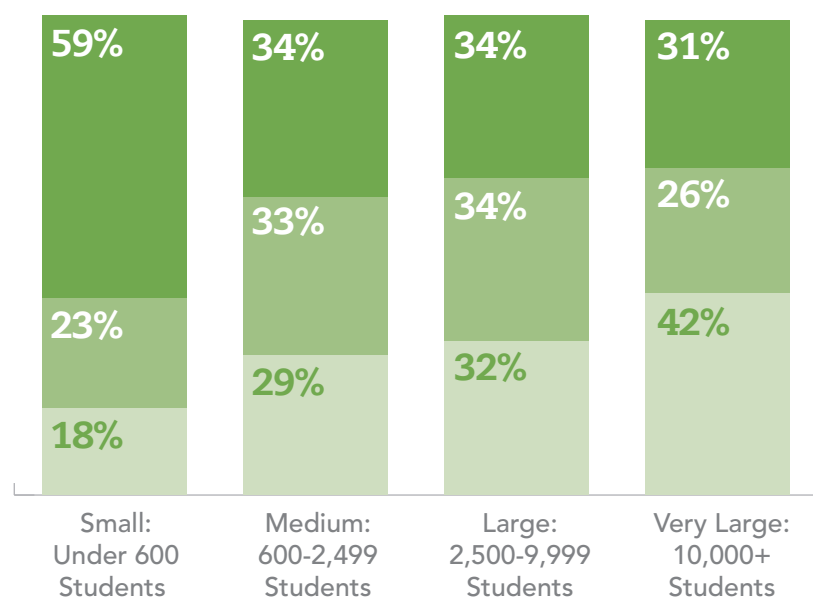

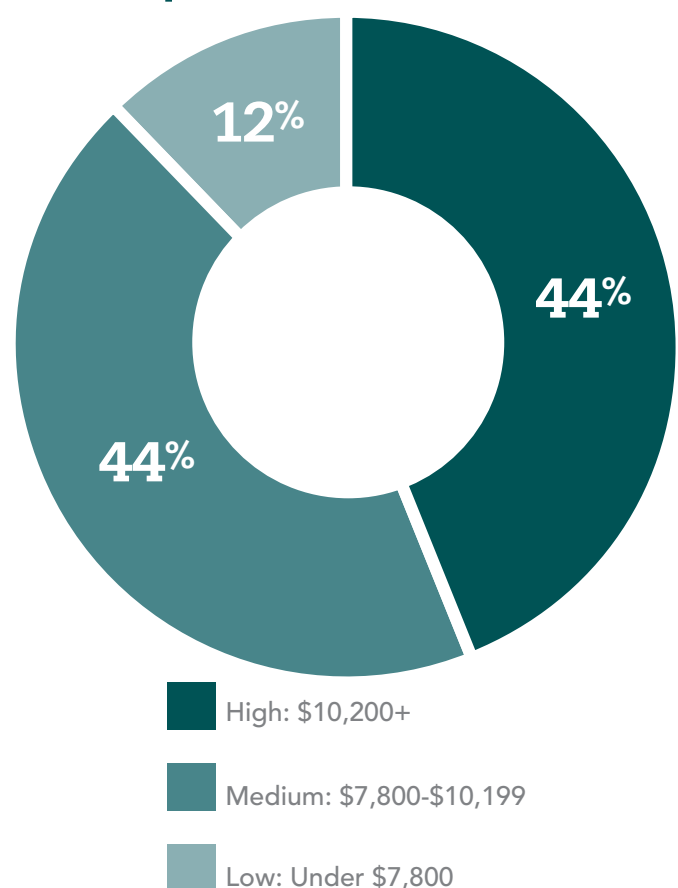
Per Student AIM Expenditure by District Enrollment
